

**BOSTON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES  
MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
July 9, 2025**

Present at this regular meeting of the Boston Township Trustees were Trustees Amy Anderson, Randy Bergdorf and Don Beal; Fiscal Officer, Pamela Schneider; Legal AI Schrader.

Trustee Anderson called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

**Announcements:** Anderson announced the passing of Joe Paradise of Summit County Engineers Office, enjoyed working with him and he had helped Boston Township several times over the years. Also, condolences to the family of Paul "Squeak" Shaver a lifelong resident of the Village of Peninsula passed.

**Police Report.** Reports received from Chief Nagy. Working on contract, received the money figures for the next three years showing a three percent increase each year. Should have the completed contract by next week to review.

**Zoning Report.** M. Anderson report distributed (absent) Bergdorf reviewed

- Bergdorf distributed copies of suggested proposed changes to zoning resolutions from Fred Guerra to the zoning commision
- 1455 W Hines Hill, Frazier family member staying at house with camper
- 3832 Oak Hill – Jenkins denied water hook-up, no building permit reviewing plans and starting over
- 6762 Riverview Rd - Rickenbacher – waiting for Summit County to come inspect and send compliance letter
- 4967 Akron Cleveland – NAPA Winery, meeting in July with Summit County for building permit. Also, need to move utility pole so (Per A. Anderson per Tim Boley (Summit County) the County said that NAPA Winery had to pay to move utility pole or goes back to BZA), earth mound grated and leveled
- 7100 Riverview Road – Boston Mills Art Festival vendor application received, 276 vendors, waiting for check \$6,900 (276 vendors x \$25)
- 5649 Akron-Cleveland Lease 4 Less – A. Anderson called EPA; they blew it off said puddles of water no smell of fuel/hydraulic fluid – no final report received yet. Packard (FD) said Groves was on vacation so hasn't been there
